

Grant County Art Association Scholarship Application

The Grant County Art Association offers a scholarship of \$1,000.00 to a graduating Grant County high school student or first year college student. The purpose of the scholarship is *to support and encourage continuing education in the field of art* at an accredited institution.

Students who have earned an accumulative 3.00 GPA and plan to take art related classes in a higher education setting are encouraged to apply.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Deadline for applications is **between 9am and 6pm on Tuesday, April 7, 2020**. Artwork will be judged on Wednesday and should be picked up **between 9am and 6pm on Thursday, April 9, 2020**.

Submit applications and artwork to: Mary Snyder, 311 S. Canyon Blvd, John Day. Phone: 541-575-0911, April 7, 2020. Retrieve from the same location April 9, 2020 before 6pm.

Each applicant must submit:

- a. A completed application form
- b. A statement of 100-150 words which outlines immediate and long-term goals *related to the field of art*.
- c. Three **original** pieces of applicant's artwork (no copies or photos of your work without prior permission).
- d. Written recommendation from your art teacher or school counselor.

The three samples of work to be submitted shall include:

- a. Black and white (charcoal, pencil, etc.)
- b. Color (watercolor, acrylic, oil, etc.)
- c. Work of applicant's choice (any medium)

To be considered for this scholarship, be sure to include all required items listed above and turn in your application before the deadline. If you have any questions please call (leave message) to Eloise Boren 541-388-4698. This scholarship is for someone who will pursue art classes.

A high school winner will be announced at his or her high school graduation exercises.

Scholarship funds will be deposited with the registrar of the institution of higher education upon notification that the student has enrolled. The scholarship is to be disbursed by the registrar for the benefit of the student. The award is to be applied to tuition, books, supplies, or other educational expenses.
