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## Position Opening:

Grant County ESD is seeking applicants for a licensed Speech Language Pathology Assistant. This position is for 32 hours per week. The successful applicant will work directly with students under supervision of the SLP, implement and assist in carrying out student goals and objectives, record data and report changes in performance of students, prepare materials, assist with clerical and recordkeeping duties, schedule students and meetings, assist and complete speech/language/ hearing screenings, and provide academic and/or behavioral supports.
